The method used is primitive hooking, that is, working with strips of fabric 14 to 12 - wide. Frames, stands, and tools are discussed. Fourteen patterns (which must be enlarged) are included, and detailed instructions are complete for each rug. There is even an explanation of why rainwater is preferable to distilled water for dyeing. Sources of supplies are appended with the author's videos and patterns getting the first mention.
