The accessories might be used as scrapbook borders, but aren't usable with the paperdolls or the background pages. The paperdolls and clothes are so finely detailed that sharp scissors and a craft knife are required for accurate cutting. The extra pieces meant for creating 3-D effects are a cute idea, but they have a lot of details that are almost too narrow to cut out, even with a craft knife. This book is for serious crafters. It brings us back to visit with old friends introduced in Mary's magazine - admit it, you kept all of them! - and offers a great selection of backdrops for lots of play-filled hours. But these poor little dollies are going to have to wear the same old outfits day after day after day. There is a tremendous opportunity lost to provide many more clothing options and we're given instead an overabundance of the dreaded white space and lots and lots of Mary's familiar flowers. I'd have loved more than four outfits for Ann Estelle on the forty pages of this book. The other dolls fare even worse. I can honestly say this book is satisfying in the quality of material presented. I just wish there might have been more clothing in the closet and less waste paper to fill the garbage can.
