See my reviews for more information on other books. Shipping of Book was Fast.. 3 Days :-) My only complaint is that it came in a plain manila envelope. No cardboard over book or plastic bubble wrap or liner. Which resulted in a slight tear in book paper cover.This was due to envelope tearing during shipping. Not a big deal since the cover was over a Hardback book. However I.M.O. experience with other Shipping this could have been avoided if either a cardboard shipping unit was used or cut cardboard was placed

around book or plastic bubble wrap liner in envelope. Since I paid under \$2 for the book approx \$4 for shipping! I feel they could have taken Better Care Of How They Packaged The Book For Shipping.... Weather ETC... With Paper Envelopes!But the Book Arrived Fast.. In contrast, this book is a conventional textbook, what you would likely find in your local vo-tech school, all the basics and history of the tradecraft. You won't find this book at Home Depot or local bookstore. Reading this book will not make you a mason, but it should help you be a less-bad DIY'er. It should also help you better appreciate the range of factors that affect masonry job estimates, and make you a better masonry customer when DIY is not a reasonable option.
