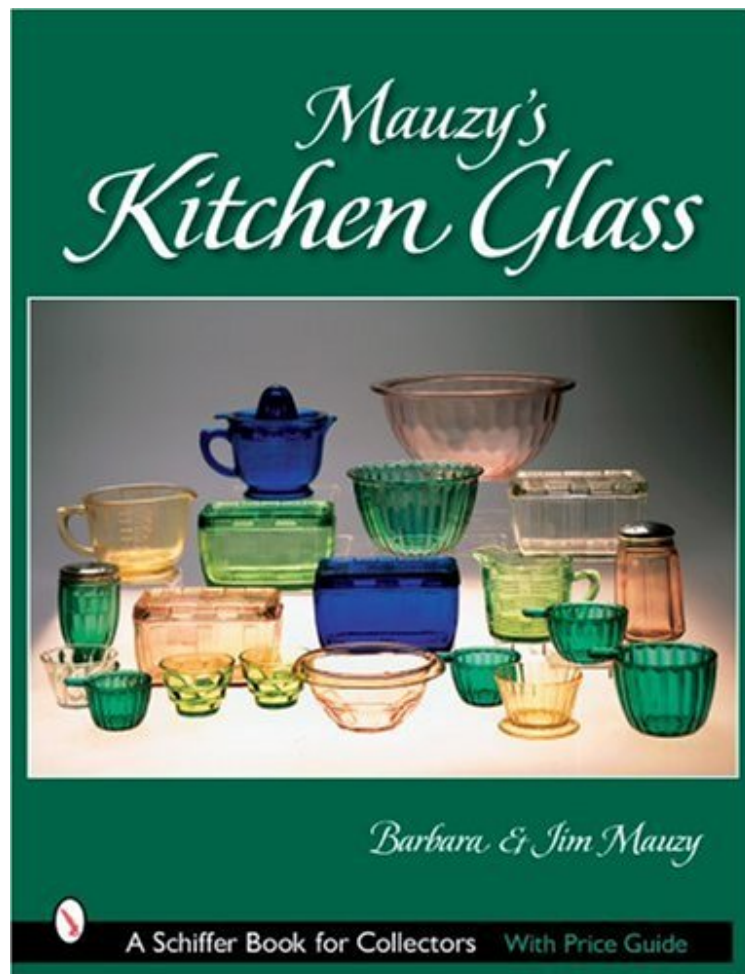

The pictures are huge, many 1/2 a page, which seems was done to make the book appear more meaty.Many of the green pieces are labeled as "unknown manufacturers", almost comical is a row of tumblers and sherbets (another row of vases) listed as "various manufacturers". That section of the book seems like they went to someone's house and just pictured each

piece. The coverage of salt and pepper shakers is quite good, almost as if that is what the book really was before adding "fluff" items. Very little information (such as dates) is given, though. With the little information given, I just don't trust the prices as being any guideline whatsoever. Disappointed.
