KnappThe individual units of the \$3 bird base are easily folded and assembled. The finished crane is impressive because of its stately size. When created using two dollar bills (for a \$6 tip), the crane is quite striking. Many origami folds are made from the bird base. Knowing how to make one using three bills is well worth the cost of this small book. A traditional star is included, from the bird base, for an impressive finished fold.
