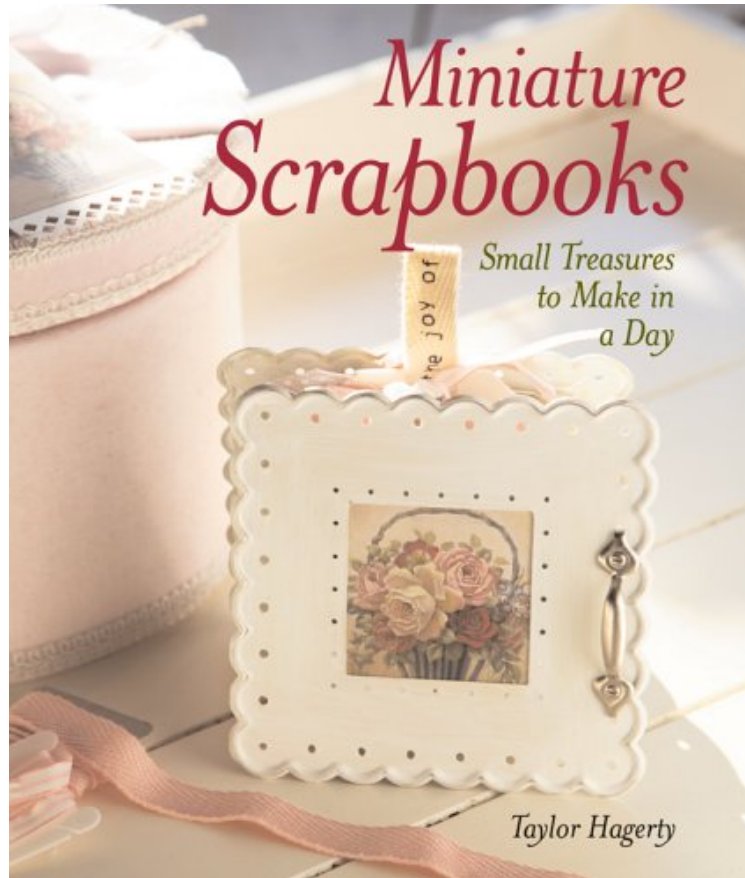

It contains over 30 step-by-step instructions that are fairly easy to follow and are appropriate for all kinds of occasions. There are little tips on the sides of the pages that will give you more ideas to get your creative juices flowing, and I'm sure you can pick and choose pieces of various projects in the book and adjust them to fit your needs. Even if you don't want to make any of these specific projects, I would say this book is still worth perusing because the photographs should give you a lot of ideas to get started with a scrapbook of any size.I wouldn't agree with the author's assertion that you can "complete a miniature scrapbook in just one sitting". Sure, if you're a pro with creating scrapbooks, it's possible, but the rest of us will have to spend a lot of time (and probably a considerable amount of money) getting these projects done, even though it's a mini. When the projects ARE done, they will look fantastic, but I'm saying they're not as easy as the writer makes it out to be. The instructions enough can be occasionally overwhelming.I haven't personally read Outstanding Mini Albums: 50 Ideas For Creating Mini Scrapbooks, but the preview I see on , it appears that that book should be more useful than this one. Along with project instructions, it contains templates, and those finished projects look a little better just because the colors aren't overpowering the overall books. Just my two cents.
