In the beginning of the book, there is a great Techniques and Glossary section for those of us who need a little refresher ;-)The Materials section of each pattern is comprehensive: explaining yarn types, Needles needed, notions, and gauge. Child patterns start as small as 3 months and some go as large as 10 years. This is great because I can use the book for many years as my daughter grows. Each pattern in the book is not only adorable but practical. There is even a matching child/doll set for one pattern. Just a note: the patterns are all set up to be for girls, however, I'm sure some of you crafty knitters out there can adapt some of them for boys. One thing I wanted to specifically praise, was the fact that not only are the sizes listed, but each size lists the measurements (i.e.; chest, bust, circumference etc.) so that you can chose the best fit.
