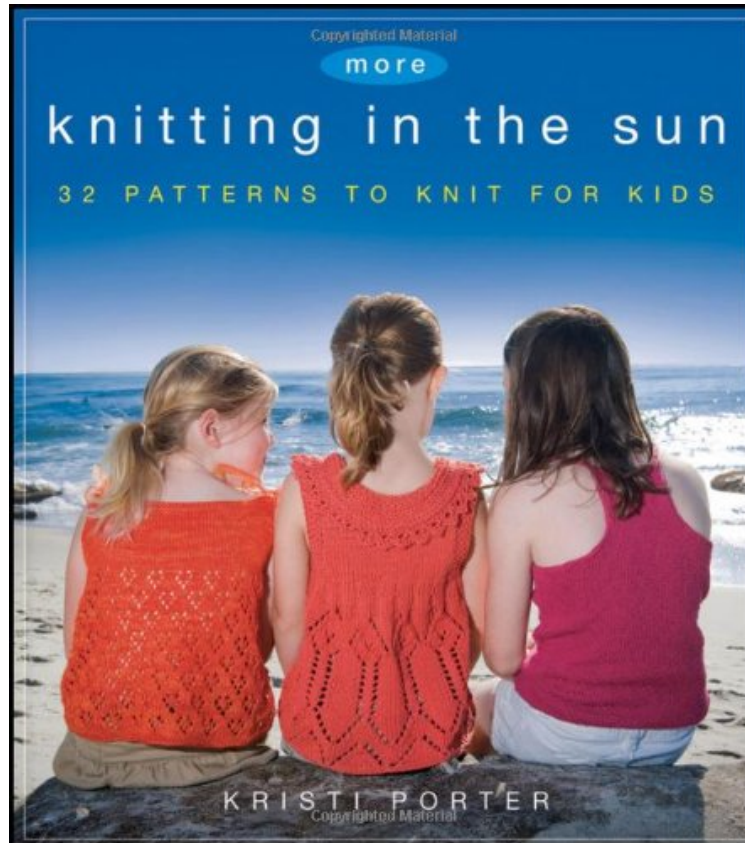

Almost all of the patterns go up to size 12! There are lots of fun outfits that go way beyond your typical sweater. I can't wait to knit the skirts, beach cover-up, board shorts and zip-up hoodie. There are plenty of dressy pieces, but all of them are clothes kids would want to wear any time because they look super comfortable. There are 2 sweet twinsets for girls that could easily be paired with skirts for a special occasion, or shorts and jeans for play. There are plenty of fun textured stitches to try, not a lot of colorwork, although there is a beautiful kimono-style wrap sweater with intarsia flowers. One note on modesty with some of the girls' sleeveless tops and dresses. The surplice sundress, although lovely, is too low-cut, in my opinion, so I would either shorten the straps or make the bodice a little bit longer. As with any garment, you can try the garment on the child as you knit it, if possible, and adjust as needed. The photographs in this book are beautiful, and show off the garment well, and the patterns look well-written. Another fun touch is that the patterns are named for characters in children's literature, such as Ramona, Hermione and Caddie! All in all, I am very satisfied with this find and can't wait to get
