Now, I made them read all of the pages that were just about the pieces and parts of sewing too, before they could start and I suggested that they make their own "sampler" fabric, to practice, before they began a project. They have immediately showed me how they are doing and decided what they like and what to make. Instantly proud of themselves and each other! They did well and had to read, and follow directions, self-motivated learning! Well done! I only wish there were a few more patterns/projects and maybe one or two more stitches described.
