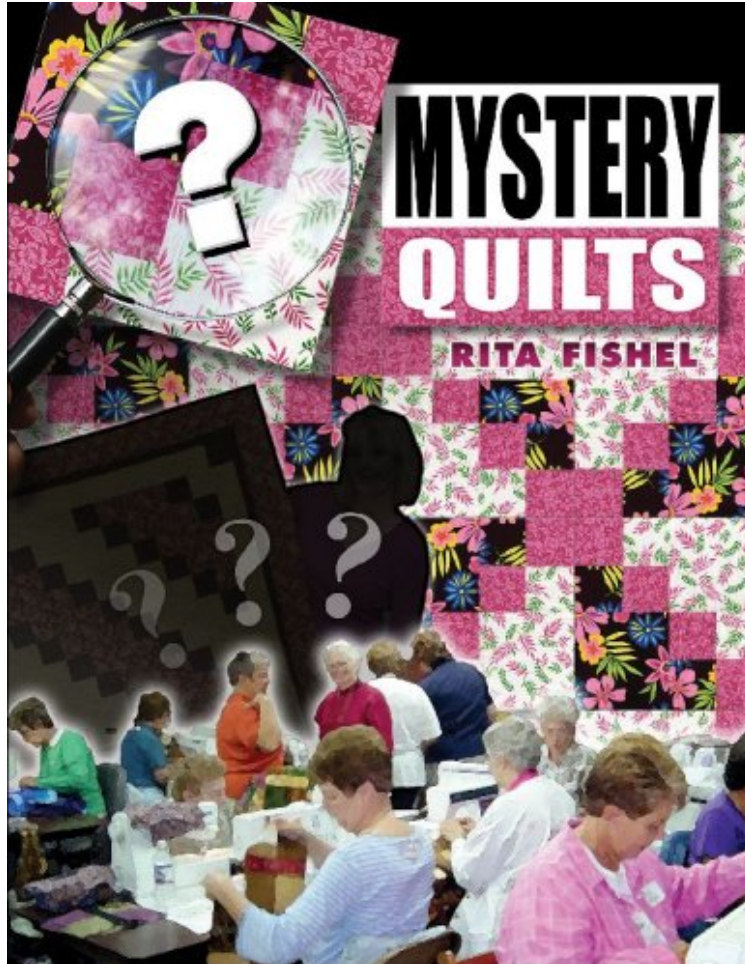

The quilt patterns in this book are all based on square or rectangular pieces. As such, these quilts are perfect for people who have little sewing or quilting experience. It would have been nice to have several quilt patterns that required triangles which would have provided variety in ability levels. I did like the addition of border fabric requirements for each quilt. Included in the text are several recipes that are perfect for quilters who love tasty foods that require little time to prepare.
