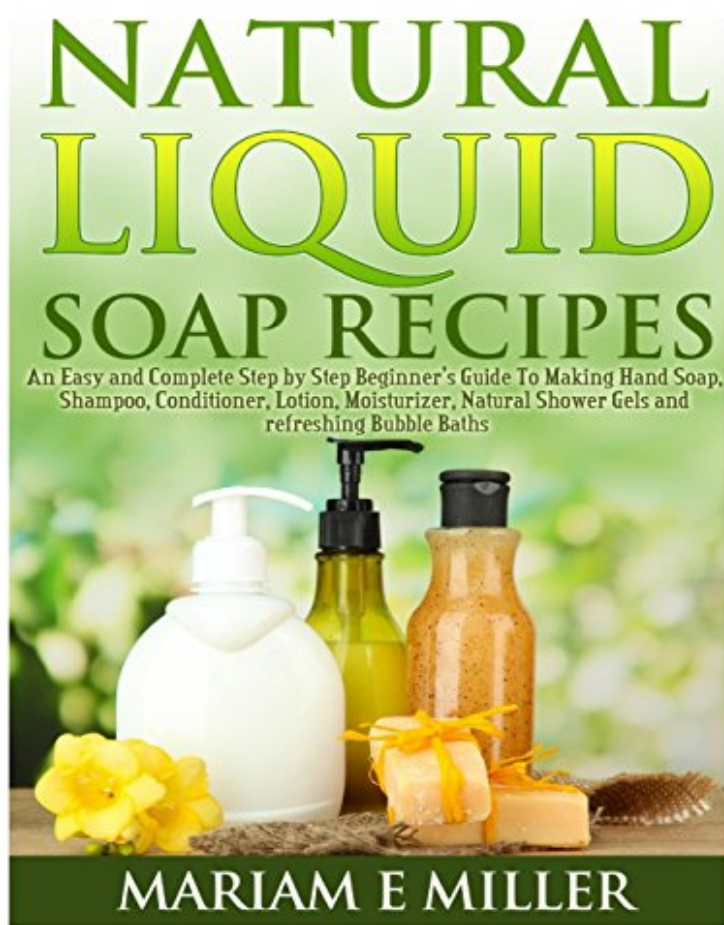

I am new to soap making and when I recieved this book was severely disappointed in it. It took me about 30 minutes to read the entire thing and it never even discussed the additional steps needed when making soap using potassium hydroxide. It discusses soap making as using two processes: the cold and hot process, which is true, but it doesn't go on to tell you that making liquid soap deviates from both of these traditional methods once you reach trace. How can you have a book titled "Natural LIQUID soap recipes" and not even give a detailed description of how to make liquid soap using potassium hydroxide? This book is a disservice to soap makers. Overall this book is not worth the money. The old adage is true...you get what you pay for. pay the extra 5 or 6 bucks and get a good book.
