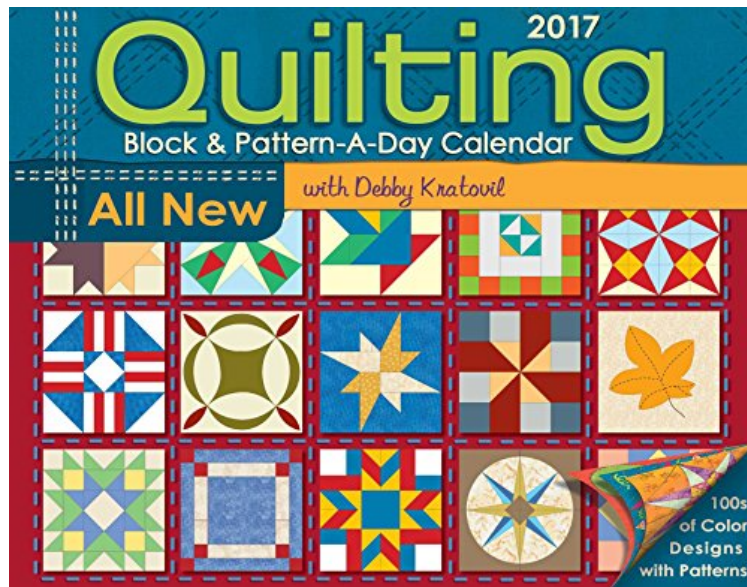

0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Disappointing. By Liz! This was not what I was expecting ... (1) The images on the front of each date are all digital designs - not images of fabric. The supplied images make it look like they have prints, but it's all computer-generated line drawings. Some of look nice, but most just look cheap. (2) The "display box" is poorly constructed - it was ripped when I was opened the package. I've purchased many crafty calendars over the years this is by far the worst box I've ever gotten. (See photo) (3) The cutting instructions suck. Most block instructions I've seen tell you how many of each size and color. These cutting notes only tell you the size shapes. Part of having a block pattern is that it should make it easier - having to flip back forth between the front (where I can see the colors) the back (where I can see the size) makes these patterns annoying. (See photos for examples) (4) There's a lot more applique than I'm interested in. I wouldn't knock any stars off for this because it's a personal preference thing, but be warned. Also, the patterns for the applique designs extra funky (See photo). (5) The 50 U.S. state quilt blocks are awful ... I have no clue how 98% of them relate to the state, they're just a bunch of triangles/rectangles/squares that are named after a state. 5 of 5 people found the following review helpful. Noice This is one of those things that you buy and when it arrives you have to laugh because it is so awful. I just wasted \$12 on the dumbest calendar ever. Most of the blocks are so basic that you will be amazed that someone bothered to make a calendar out of these. It is not like the pages have pretty examples of actual quilt blocks. Nope, just a square with a few triangles and regular colors like red or blue; not fabric photos. This

is the lamest thing I have ever bought. It doesn't even come with a thing to put the pages in so you can use it like a real desk calendar other than the cardboard box which they expect you to leave the pages in. Make sure you don't rip the box or you just ripped your calendar stand. I cannot believe anyone would give this a good review. It is horrible and going in the trash. The box it comes in is the only interesting thing about it.
