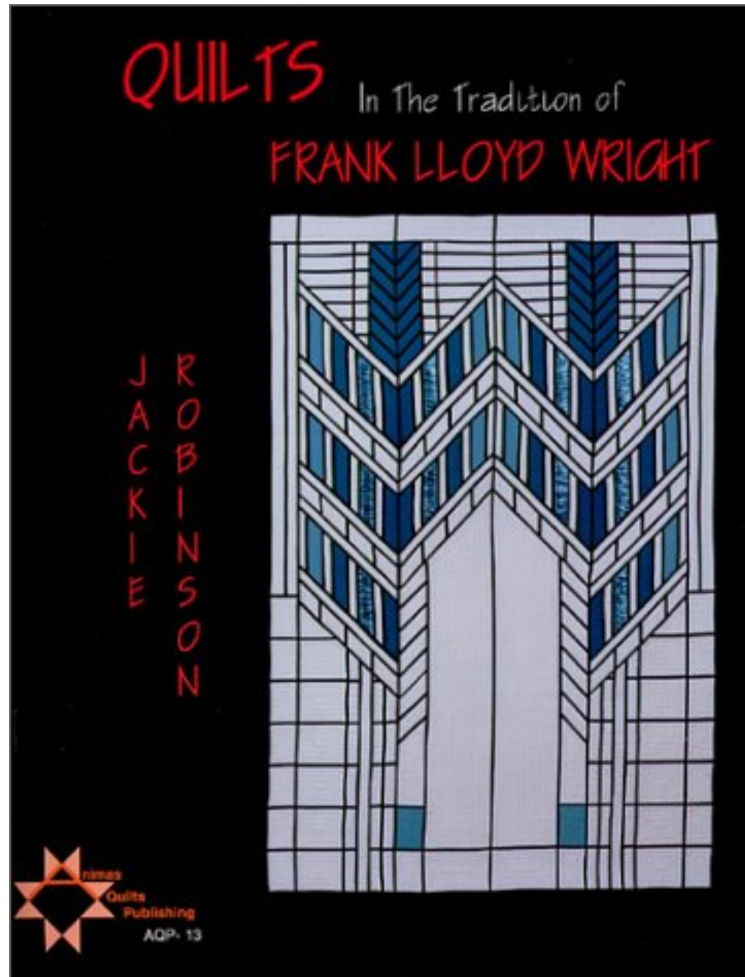

She's the author of twelve books on quilting, as well as numerous patterns.
