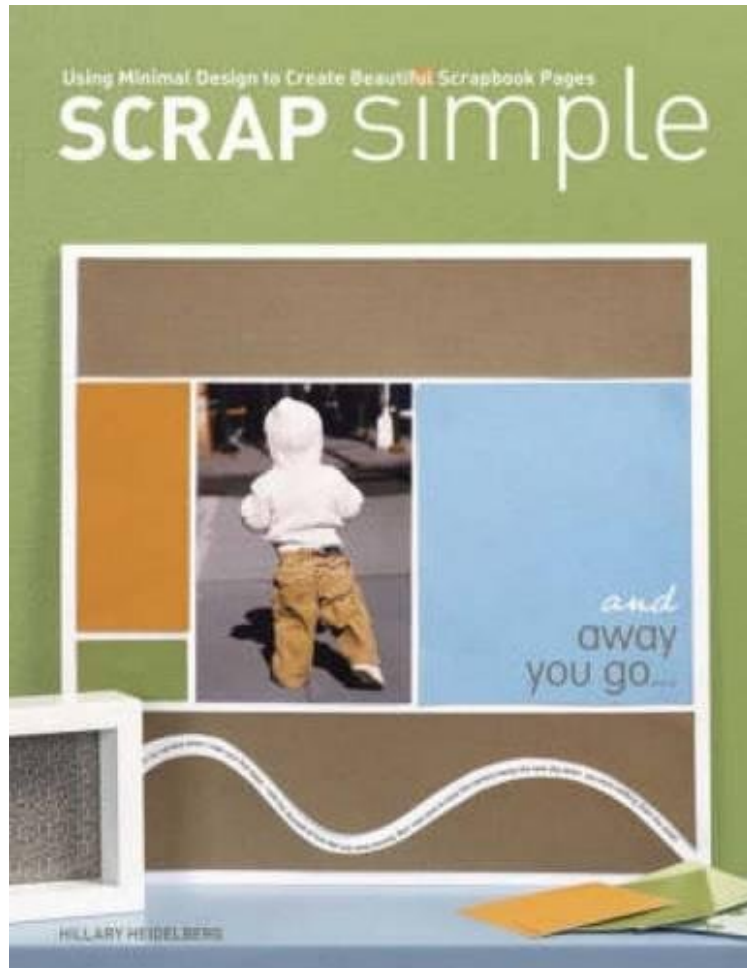

I've found myself returning again and again for ideas for laying out my pages in simple yet compelling ways. If you're a practitioner of shabby chic, look elsewhere: here we have clean lines, a few curves, and carefully selected patterned papers and embellishments - not a ribbon, torn edge, or stacked frame to be found. Perhaps one of the most useful things about this book for me is that 90% of the example pages feature boys - a real rarity in a genera which naturally lends itself to girls in frilly dresses.
